


The Military Wives Choirs is a community of over 2000 women in 72 choirs across the UK and internationally who come together to celebrate a love of singing and a communal understanding that comes from their members' shared experiences of the Armed Forces.

We are delighted to be joined by them on Friday 8th November, the choir will perform their own pieces as well as join forces with the band for several joint items.

The evening of music will will honour the service of, and the sacrifices made by British Armed Forces personnel, those who served in the past and those currently serving.

The evening will culminate in a Drumhead Service, a simple and dignified ceremony where Regimental drums are placed on top of each other to form an altar. This echoes a tradition dating back to the 1700s, when soldiers about to go into battle required a place for reflection and remembrance of their fallen comrades in the face of difficult times ahead. Once the drums are stacked, the Standards are lowered, and the Last Post sounds and a two-minute silence is observed.

Tickets will be available to purchase at the beginning of September. We will be supporting the Royal British Legion on the night with a portion of the proceeds going to the charity.
